

# *Bloomin' Cogwheels*

Homework: Please bring the four strip sets from page 2 and 1/2 yard of background fabric to class.

To make the strip sets, keep the following in mind:

- \* *Set your stitch length to 2.0.*
- \* *If using needle position for seam allowance, set the needle at 4.0. This is generally the setting for a 1/4" seam allowance, otherwise, use a 1/4" foot.*
- \* *Do not sew with a scant 1/4" seam allowance.*
- \* *Strip Set #1A and Strip Set #2A will go together in the same plate so you need to cut the same fabrics for both strip sets.*
- \* *Strip Set #1B and Strip Set #2B will go together in a separate plate and so these two should have the same fabrics (but different from the previous strip sets).*
- \* *You can use solids, prints or some combination for the strip sets. Prints of varying size also work well as do coordinated prints. Jelly rolls will work for the strip sizes up to 2 1/2".*
- \* *Fabric colors that work best in the Bloomin' Cogwheels plates are those with the most variation in intensity.*

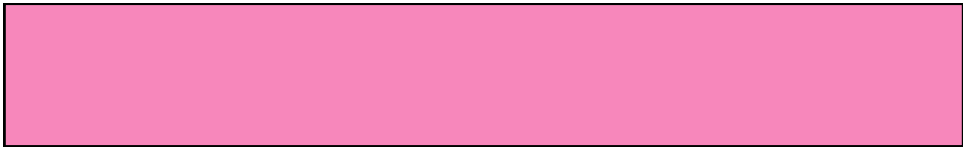
