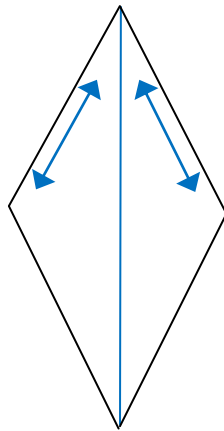
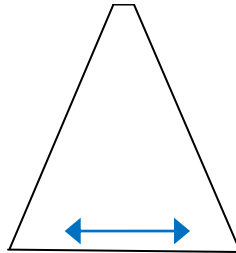


Diamond in a Triangle

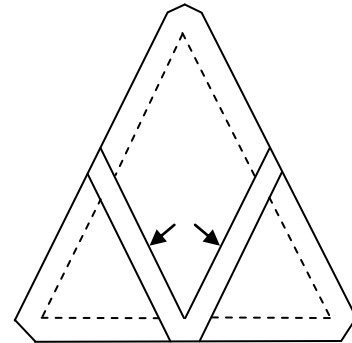
The Diamond In A Triangle Ruler set includes the following pieces:



Center Diamond



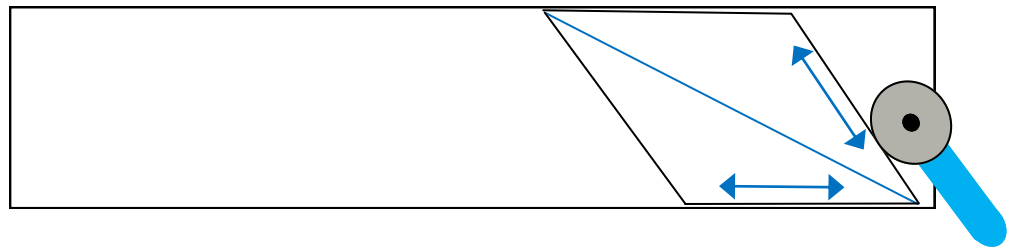
Side Triangles



Trimming Ruler

Starch fabric before cutting.
Starch front of fabric, let soak in and then iron dry from the wrong side.

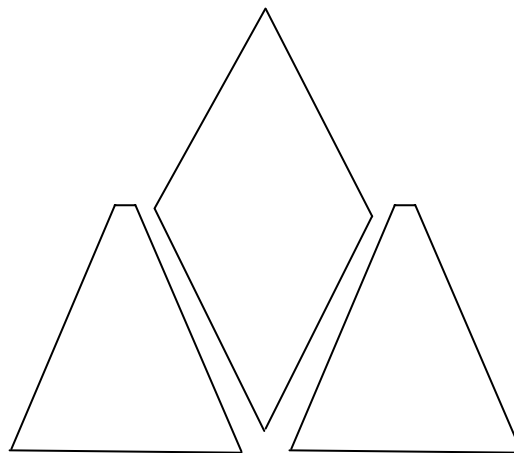
Cut out Center Diamond shapes from a strip of fabric.



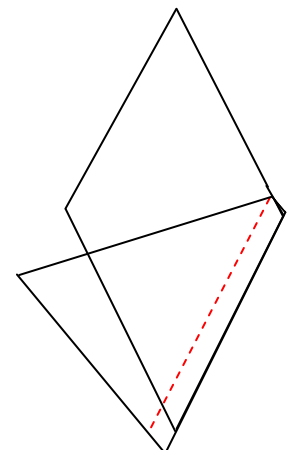
Cut out side triangles from a strip of fabric.



Arrange (2) side triangles and (1) Center Diamond as shown.



Flip the triangle on the right onto the diamond so the triangle matches the side of the center diamond and you have right sides together.
Stitch 1/4" seam allowance.



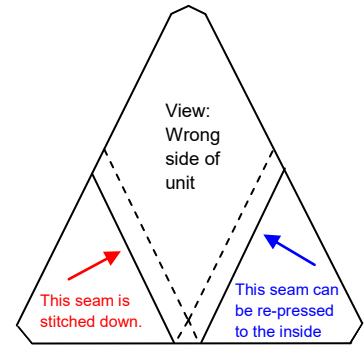
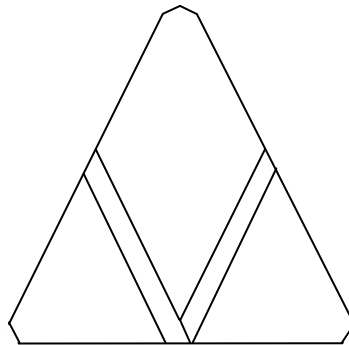
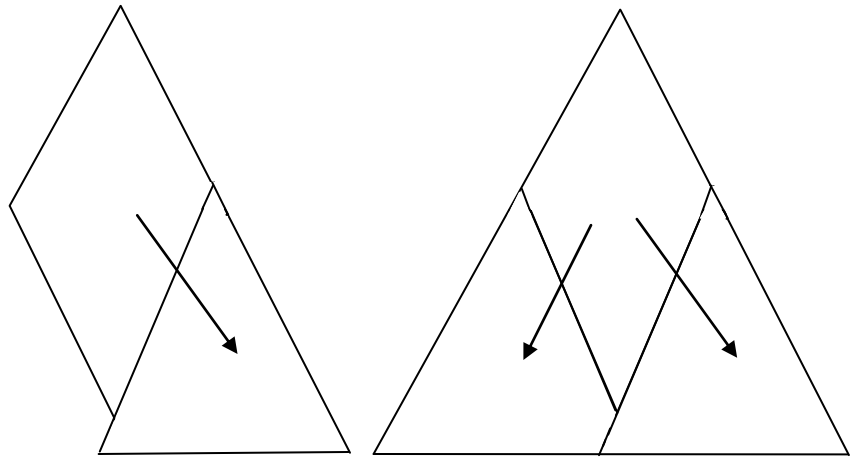
Finger press seam to the outside of the unit.

Arrange and sew the left triangle to the unit and press seam to the outside of the unit.

The Diamond in a Triangle unit will now be oversized, especially at the bottom.

Lock the grooved template over the seams completely *from the right side* and then trim around the entire unit.

Turn the unit over and notice both seams. One of the seams can be pressed toward the inside of the unit. Finger press to the inside and then press again with an iron.



You will need (6) Diamond in a Triangle units for a complete star but do not join all six. Instead, join (3) at a time to make a half-hexagon.

Make all the half-hexagons and then join them together into rows by rotating every other half-hex.

Remember that you will need to match at each star point.

Join the rows together to finish every star.
